



A walk around the river – Saturday 2 October

This year our Parish walk will be a stroll around the Canning River, starting in Salter Point, over Canning Bridge, along to Deep Water Point, continuing south to cross the river on the Mt Henry Bridge, then back again to our starting point & afternoon tea at Alan & Susanne's nearby home.

Meet at 1.00 at the freeway pedestrian bridge, at the top corner of Edgewater Rd Salter Point (roadside parking available). Please be on time if you are coming to the start point.

We will leave *promptly* and continue as follows, in the direction of the arrows on your map:

1.05-1.40	Meeting point to Canning Bridge, & to the beach area near the rowing sheds	2.2km
	Rest point	
1.45-2.10	Rowing sheds along the Esplanade to Deep Water Point (Dome)	1.5km
	Rest point	
2.25-2.50	Deep Water Point along the Esplanade to Mt Henry Bridge Reserve	1.6km
	Rest point	
3.00-3.30	Mt Henry Bridge footbridge (south side in the shade) to the beginning point	1.7km
	Then a short walk to refreshments at 59 Mount Henry Rd	0.5km
	Total distance approximately	7.5km

Join us for the whole walk, a short stroll on one of the sections, meet us for a quick chat at the Dome rest point or just come for afternoon tea at the end. If you choose to bring your dog for the walk, please be aware that the dog *cannot* be brought to the house after the walk.
